COURSE AIM

The aim of the Rigging & Slinging - Banksman Level 2 With Assessment is to provide the learners a basic level of competence for supervisory techniques required for riggers safety and important factors of toolbox meetings.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Rigging & Slinging - Banksman Level 2 With Assessment are that learners will be able to

- 1) Accident caused during lifting
- Company procedures and legislations.
- 3) Wire rope slings and wire rope
- 4) Webbing slings / shackles / chain hoist
- 5) Safe working loads / tension and angles
- 6) Bulldog grips / blocks / plate clamps
- 7) Fall arrest devices / winches / wire rope sockets
- 8) Correct use and limitation of wire rope / slings and lifting appliances
- 9) Mooring activities / ropes / containers / lifting operations and techniques
- 10) Crane operations / inspection / safety auditing
- 11) Communication / presentation skills / Toolbox meeting / rigger assessment
- 12) Practical exercises involving planning a lift, toolbox meeting, and presentation skills

PRE-REQUISITES

All learners must have

- 1) Possess a valid, current medical certificate
- 2) Completed Rigging and Slinging Level 1 with assessment.
